



ECU Student Guild: Second hand Textbooks Sales and Collection Service

Conditions of Sale & Collection:

The ECU Student Guild provides second hand textbook sales service through our online Shopify store:

The sale of our second hand books is in accordance with the conditions defined below:

1. This service is **only** available to currently registered and studying ECU students, as well as, graduated students for the 12 months following their graduation date.
2. All books are listed as '**Fixed Price**' and the Guild will not entertain offers or reduce the price of listings. In the interests of offering students the best price possible we only apply sufficient mark-up to cover Shopify and PayPal subscriptions and sales fees.
3. Eligible students can purchase second hand books through our online store by using **PayPal or Cash on Delivery** as our preferred payment method.
4. **All book purchases (cash and PayPal) are to be process via our online store.**
5. All Mt Lawley and Joondalup campus students are required to collect their book purchases from the ECU Student Guild Joondalup office (details below). Students can opt to collect their purchase from the ECU Student Guild Mt Lawley campus, however this must be clearly specified upon purchase. There are NO POSTAGE services available for Joondalup and Mt Lawley campus students.
6. Bunbury and off-campus students may be eligible to get their purchased books posted free of charge, however they will need to contact the ECU Student Guild Bookshop Officer for further information.
