# **Environmental Sustainability Department – Report (Oliver Kung)**

Over the last month I initiated the following project, these beings:

- Automatic Water Taps (To reduce the run time of push button water taps)
- ECU Garden Farmbot (automated garden)
- ECU Guild Solar offset Proposal

#### **Automatic water taps**

Basically I called up a pile of companies who sold sensor activated taps and was quoted between \$120 - \$160 per sensor tap making the implementation of this project unfeasible for the quantity of taps that I intended to change (20).

## **ECU Garden Farmbot**

The plan was to utilise open source software from FARMBOT to create an autonomous watering system that would care for the ECU Student Garden. However, this would take away the need to have volunteers to water and care for the garden. While this sounds good in theory, after having facilitated the "How to Farm" event I realised that having an autonomous garden robot would detract from the social aspect of caring for the garden. For this reason I have rejected the notion of an autonomous FARMBOT.

## **ECU Guild Solar Offset Proposal**

To initiate this project, I needed to find out how much energy ECU Guild uses. To do this I contacted and met with Paul Wyatt (Manager Electrical Services. Buildings and Services). He stated that I mount a kwh meter to the side of the building to accurately measure the power used by the guild. This would cost \$3000, yet again way outside the \$600 I initially thought it would cost.

An alternate option would be to manually calculate the power consumption of the guild which is possible but would take some time. However, as this process is not as accurate as installing a meter. A project of this nature needs proper evaluation, if it intends to be successful and a proof of concept for other solar projects.

This is the only project from the initial set of projects that is still active.
